



Instructions for processing of DEVA Peat-Silk

If you have purchased DEVA peat-silk by the meter, you can make (or let make) your own textiles. Your seamstress or your tailor should have experience in dealing with silk fabrics.

The fabrics are activated and sprayed with finishing bath. Please treat the material with care and avoid storing it near electrical appliances or other sources of interference. Of course, you can use an electric sewing machine for the production.

They enhance the positive properties of peat silk by incorporating additionally refined peat fibres into the garment, for example by providing wide seams and sewing small amounts of peat fibres into the seams. This is also useful in the production of covers for pillows or duvets. It can be just as helpful to work in small pieces of clothing with small piles filled with peat fibres.

If you are processing DEVA peat-silk fleece for blankets, pillows or lined clothing, the same applies: Put a thin puff of peat fibres over or under the silk fleece before it is sewn in place.

The refining bath for refreshing (e.g. after the wash) can also be found under the above link in the shop. It comes in a handy 100 ml spray bottle.

Peat-silk yarn is not yet sprayed with refining bath. If you knit or weave with yarn, it is therefore advisable to spray the finished end product with refining bath.
